NIRV - ..."The One who sets you free"...

Jeremiah 29:10-11 This is what the Lord says: "When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will come to you and fulfill my good promise to bring you back to this place. **11** For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Jeremiah 50:34 Yet their Redeemer is strong; the LORD Almighty is his name. He will vigorously defend their cause so that he may bring rest to their land,

Matthew 1:21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."

Redeem- Definition

- to buy back : REPURCHASE, to get or win back
- to free from what distresses or harms: such as
 - a: to free from captivity by payment of ransom
 - b: to extricate from or help to overcome something detrimental
 - c: to release from blame or debt : CLEAR
 - d: to free from the consequences of sin
- to change for the better : REFORM
- REPAIR, RESTORE
- to atone for : EXPIATE
redeem an error
- to offset the bad effect of, to make worthwhile : RETRIEVE
