21 Days of Prayer and Fasting

Holiness is the work of the Holy Spirit

- **John 16:8** “And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment”
- **1 Corinthians 6:19** “Do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?”
- **1 Corinthians 3:17** “If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are.”
- **Ezekiel 36:27** “I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances”
- **Galatians 5:22** “The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.”
- **Philippians 2:13** “It is God who is working in you, enabling you both to desire and to work out His good purpose”
- **Hebrews 12:14** “Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.”

Repentance from sin is necessary for a deep work of the Holy Spirit

Acts 3:19 “Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord.”

Psalms 51:10-11 “Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from your presence; take not Your Holy Spirit from me.”

Praise God

- He makes us Holy through the power of the Holy Spirit
- We are the temple of the Holy Spirit

Confess

Any sin, thought, word or deed that grieves the Holy Spirit

Ask God

- To search your heart for any sin, word, or deed that grieves the Holy Spirit
- Confess it to the Lord
- Repent of that sin
- For a spirit of prayer and repentance in your own life
- For a spirit of prayer and repentance in our church and community
- For victory over sin through a deeper relationship with the Holy Spirit
