Thank God

- For being your Source of all that you have ever and will ever need
 - Remember the times that He came through for you
- For leading you through the high and low moments of your life
 - Think of specific times that He carried you through

Confess

- Any of the times that you have relied on another source other than Him
 - Job, relationship, goal or habit

- That you felt abandoned by Him

Ask God

- To help you have His shepherd heart for the lost.

- To look to Him for wisdom and direction in your life
 - He guides our paths, leads us to the places that we need to be. Think of some areas, in your life, that you need His wisdom for.
