

Jehovah Shalom (The Lord Is Peace)

Other names: Prince of Peace, The God of Peace, Shalom

Scripture background: The name Jehovah Shalom first appears in Scripture in the story of Gideon.

Judges 6:23-24 “Then the Lord said to him, ‘Peace be with you; do not fear, you shall not die.’ So Gideon built an altar there to the Lord, and called it The-Lord-Is-Peace [Jehovah Shalom]”

Isaiah 9:6 “His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.”

- Shalom is not the absence of conflict or stress – it is the presence of God. A sense of wholeness or completion.

Ephesians 2:24 “He himself is our peace . . . “

- To live in peace is to live in His presence
 - Peace with God
 - Peace with others
 - Peace with ourselves

Colossians 3:15 “Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of your body you were called to peace. “

Praise God

- He is the source of all peace
- For showing us the way to peace

Thank God

- Thank God for the peace you have experienced in your life

Confess

- Any failure to forgive

Ask God

- To help you live at peace with others.

- **Isaiah 32:17-18** “ The fruit of that righteousness will be peace; its effect will be quietness and confidence forever. My people will live in peaceful dwelling places, in secure homes, in undisturbed places of rest.”
- To help you be a person who spreads peace, not chaos.
